ATTENTION BAY COUNTY RESIDENTS AND VISITORS: For your protection and a healthier environment, this area may be treated with one or more of the following materials to help control mosquitoes.

Date of Application: **APRIL—OCTOBER**

The following habitats may be treated: artificial containers, cross country drains, flooded fields, flood plains, flooded woodlots, idle swimming pools, ponds, pickle vats, roadside ditches, sewage lagoons, tires, and tree holes. Outdoor public recreation areas (i.e., campgrounds, rest areas, parks, playgrounds, picnic areas, athletic fields) may also be treated to reduce the mosquito population. Method of application may include hand-held spreaders, hand-held pressure sprayers, or truck-mounted ultra-low volume cold aerosol foggers.
