NOMINATIONS FOR THIS OFFICE WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE BAY COUNTY CLERK BY THE RESPECTIVE DEMOCRAT AND REPUBLICAN PARTY CHAIRPERSONS BY MARCH 7, 2021.

VOTING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE KAWKAWLIN TOWNSHIP HALL, 1836 EAST PARISH ROAD, KAWKAWLIN, MICHIGAN, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING A VACANCY OF ONE (1) TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR THIS ELECTION 45 DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF SAID ELECTION; REGISTERED VOTERS MAY CONTACT THE LOCAL CLERK TO OBTAIN AN APPLICATION FOR AN ABSENT VOTER BALLOT.

TO COMPLY WITH THE HELP AMERICAN VOTE ACT (HAVE), VOTING INSTRUCTIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE IN AUDIO FORMAT AND BRAILLE. ARRANGEMENTS FOR OBTAINING THE INSTRUCTIONS IN THESE ALTERNATE FORMATS CAN BE MADE BY CONTACTING THE TOWNSHIP CLERK IN ADVANCE OF THE ELECTION. ALL POLLING LOCATIONS ARE ACCESSIBLE FOR VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES.
