Trustee Campbell said a prayer before meeting began in memory of 9-11-01.

**Call Meeting to Order**—Kruse called meeting to order at 6:00 pm with the pledge to the flag.

**Roll Call of Officers**—Present: Campbell, DeShano, Klass, Kruse  
Absent: Davidson, excused

**Public Input-(3 minute limit, not a Q & A session)-**

1. Brad Eddy-1890 S. Huron Rd.- questioned if he was going to get paid for the blight cleanup he did on Wetters Rd. and Mara Dr., also opposes rezoning of property next to his.
2. Lisa Eurich-2890 Two Mile Rd., gave a copy of a letter she received in mail on August 31, 2023 to each of the Board Members present and asked for it to be put in correspondence

- A. Bills and Payroll for approval—

Motion made by DeShano/Campbell to approve payroll. Yes: Klass, Kruse, Campbell, DeShano **Passed**
- B. Budget Adjustment- Deputy Supervisor-Motion made by Campbell/Klass to move \$1,000.00 from each of the Deputy Clerk's and Deputy Treasurer's budgets for the Deputy Supervisor, Greg Petrimoulx, to cover wages and taxes. Yes: Klass, Kruse, Campbell, DeShano **Passed** This may need to be revisited, depending upon the length of Supervisor Davidson's medical leave.
- C. Linwood Scenic Point Park Seawall- Trustee Campbell reported estimated cost of seawall is \$400,000.00. At this time, grants from 5 different partners, total approx. \$473,000.00. Out of these funds, the grant from DNR for \$201,000.00 cannot be used for things that will touch water, so it can't be used for seawall, leaving project about \$200,000.00 short. Motion was made by Campbell to earmark \$80,000.00 from ARPA money to be donated toward seawall project. After much discussion, Campbell modified his motion to earmark \$60,000.00 from ARPA to seawall project, DeShano seconded the motion. Yes: Kruse, Campbell, DeShano, Klass **Passed**
- D. Regular Board Meeting September 25, 2023- Trustee DeShano feels the meeting today was not called correctly and feels the Board does not need to meet again until October 10th
