NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

ZONING ORDINANCE INTERPRETATION

The Kawkawlin Township Zoning Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on April 2, 2026, at 7:00 p.m., at the Kawkawlin Township Hall, 1836 Parish Road, Kawkawlin, MI 48631, to consider an interpretation of the Kawkawlin Township Zoning Ordinance, as provided for in Section 904, namely the meaning of “incinerator” found in Article II of the Ordinance.

A request was made that the Zoning Board of Appeals interpret “incinerator” within the context of the I-2 zoning district where it is allowed as a special land use and 170 S Huron Road, Kawkawlin, MI 48631. The ZBA will consider whether “incinerator” includes within its scope a crematorium as a land use. A copy of the interpretation request is available for inspection at the Kawkawlin Township Hall, 1836 Parish Road, Kawkawlin, MI 48631, and also will be available for inspection at the public hearing. Written comments on the proposed ordinance amendments will be received by the Township at the Township Hall prior to the public hearing or at the public hearing. Oral comments may also be made at the public hearing.

Kawkawlin Township will provide auxiliary aids or services to individuals with disabilities. Persons needing such services should contact the office of the Township Clerk by writing or calling the Clerk not less than four (4) days before the public hearing.
