8. Department/Committee Reports
 - a. Fire Department (Chief Bernreuter)
 - i. Engine 14 had a low tire on 20th, they're all due to be replaced in the Fall. New HT has arrived. Pagers that need to be repaired. Blood Drive: had 15 people, 6 personnel from FD. Want to order paint sprayer from Amazon (\$47) wash out on main drive of FD replaced 4-5 years ago, another hole getting worse. Phone in squad room needs to be fixed. 8/24 will have car

seat safety inspection at fire station. Spoke with Brad and Laurie about Garfield Fire Station, need help. Have a number in mind that would more than cover the cost of personnel and fuel cost for the truck. They only run on average about 10 calls/month. Bio-Care coming up in September, yearly. Full Time guys working out well, has been a rough couple of months, since May. Fire recovery has gotten 4 checks so far in the last two months. At 35 calls for the month so far.

- i. Citations: 2601, 1327 and 24 Fraser Rd and 2601 River Rd. Spoke with owners to work with us, saved 2 lawsuits. 111 Guy St homeowner worked with me. 2220 Mosher Rd, grass height, made a big difference. Two home garage permits issued, met on 333 S Linwood Beach (24x36) Called DTE for a property on Huron Rd seven times, will revisit. Marijuana complaints, had one, issue was addressed. 7 Mile and Parish, 40 year “mess” all properties given 2 week notice, about a week into it now, will revisit. 1039 Brissette Beach. Put 127 miles on the car driving around to properties. Worked with title company regarding property on Wetters Rd that was sold for cash. There are 3 properties that I cannot reach: Marion St x Cottage Grove-fire hazard. Would like to get 3 bids for cutting crew for grass. Property on Huron Rd with defunct factory, allegedly from Frankenmuth. DTE Place have reached out 7 times. Would like to get bids for 3 cutting crews to fix issue and put the bill on their property taxes. DeShano: will check on grass and weed ordinance to see what is allowed before moving forward. Blohm: asked if these were the only complaints received since you took over? McCormick: there are a few more.

b. Invoices

i. Waldee: bills include some end of June and July bills. Campbell: have to have something straightened out with John Hancock. Payroll automatically calculates 2% and we pay to them via EFT. DeShano: questions about road commission bill, concerns about “Build Better Roads.” Whalen: will likely end up owing \$30,000 on the next invoice. Campbell: deduct \$807.24 from road commission bill for Seidlers Rd. DeShano: questions about planning bill. Campbell: spoke with Don [Hamilton] regarding journals, needed addresses to make sure we’re not paying Troy [McCormick] twice for something that was already done. Hamilton: we had given monthly journals to the board. Campbell: journals didn’t indicate exact addresses. Found letters in Zoning office, not mentioned in journals. DeShano: this billing also includes Tom [Reif] and yourself [Don Hamilton], correct? Hamilton: yes. DeShano: concern is that if we don’t know who he spoke to or that if a zoning permit is in a file, we would like to have a copy so that we know where things had left off. Hamilton: there needs to be a better way of keeping records. Whalen: we had hoped that by hiring a professional that it would get better and more streamlined. The people before and after have kept substantially better records. Not trying to take away from the work he did.

c. Planning Commission

- i. Trent(Attorney): Planning Commission considering 3 amendments to zoning ordinance. Reason for delay, our office had not completed the legal review. Our office has since completed the review and provided confidential legal opinion to the board on those three amendments. No opinion as to whether or not these are good policy choices for the township. There are specific requirements in the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act for passing zoning amendments. Board is welcome to consider each of these amendments individually.
- ii. DeShano: concern about miscommunication in how those amendments progressed from planning to the office to the board to the attorney. We hadn't received anything until last minute previously.
- iii. Don: all three had been approved at previous [planning commission] meetings, before you [DeShano] had joined the planning commission.
- iv. Campbell: were definitions written for religious institutions?
- v. Don: No, not at this time.
- vi. Blohm: approved not allowing any religious institutions that goes against the constitution.
- vii. Don: if this was approved by the board, then the definitions would go in the zoning ordinance to clarify what is or is not permitted.
- viii. DeShano: based on the legal review, there are some serious legal concerns as written, in the amendments that were brought forward that open up potential legal problems. Don: all of the amendments? DeShano: yes, there were problems at every level. Concerned that this was pushed through very quickly. Mixed use district is a very big change to make to overall zoning, to rush it is concerning, there are unintended consequences. Feel that we have legal obligations to pause on moving forward until we have clarity on the terms and definitions.

- f. Cemetery – Maintenance/Clean Up
 - i. Campbell: met at the cemetery, cleaned up 11 trees in the front, now have grass by columbarium. Cemetery board would like to address weekly cuttings. Price to cut park: \$55/week, North Section: \$100 additional every two weeks. Enforce the ordinance, items not permitted, can have 12 in ring on grave or shepherd's hook. There are graves with several items on it that do not meet the ordinance, people are filing complaints that it does not look good. Post a sign on each entrance, put an article in the Pinconning Journal, the Facebook page. A sign that would be made to say, "It's clean up time, remove all unauthorized items within 14 days. Thank you, Heavenly Rest Cemetery, Kawkawlin Township." It's a touchy subject.
 - ii. Blohm: who interprets the opinion on what doesn't fit?
 - iii. Campbell: ordinance says, "one item per grave." Ordinance is law. There are graves throughout that are clearly in violation.
 - iv. Campbell: additional cutting in cemetery, park for \$55/week and North section for \$100/bi-weekly.
 - v. Whalen: Motion to approve cutting at \$310 extra per month for added on sections and by the columbarium where the trees were removed
 - vi. 2nd: DeShano
