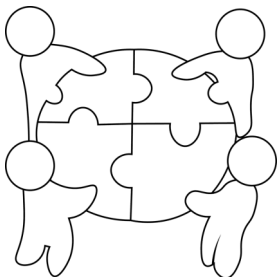

- ⇒ Place your container 3-4 feet from mailboxes, trees, shrubs, vehicles, and other obstructions by 6 AM on day of service, with handles and wheels pointed away from the roadway.
- ⇒ To avoid spillage please bag all materials and do not overload containers.
- ⇒ Bulk waste (appliances, furniture) should be set out on your regular collection day, slightly separate from container. You can schedule these items for pickup but it is not required. (This does not include large clean outs, remodeling or move ins and move outs - this requires a dumpster.)
 - ⇒ Refrigerators and freezers must have doors and racks removed.
 - ⇒ Freon must be removed and a certification sticker must be attached.
- ⇒ Disposal of hazardous chemicals with your household trash is prohibited.
- ⇒ Yard waste includes garden waste, leaves, lawn cuttings, shrubs, and trees.
 - ⇒ Dirt, sod, large stumps, sand, gravel, stones, and animal feces are NOT YARD WASTE.
 - ⇒ Yard waste will be collected in up to 35 gallon containers (clearly marked as yard waste) or brown paper yard waste bags.
 - ⇒ For your convenience, the large yard waste dumpster is available at the township office, at the southern end of the western-most driveway.
